Performing Arts (Dance)

BTEC Award

- Equivalent to 1 GCSE (nationally recognised)
- Vocational: A flexible way to learn & be examined
- 3 units/components
- ▶ Two units are assessed internally, one is external.
- 5 lessons of dance over 2 weeks.
- Include both theory and practical elements.
- ▶ Graded: Level 1 Pass, Merit and Distinction and Level 2 Pass, Merit and Distinction

Component 1 - Exploring the Performing Arts (Dance). Internally Assessed.

Assessment: A presentation of knowledge: 3 dance pieces and their choreography process.

Component 2- Developing Skills and Techniques in Dance. Internally Assessed.

Assessment: Participate in dance workshops to develop and enhance dance technical skills ready for performance.

Rehearse and perform a choreographed dance piece.

Component 3- Performing to a Brief. 48 guided Learning Hours. Externally Assessed.

Assessment: Create a dance performance in response to a given brief. Complete 3 written responses based on your progress as a dancer.

- Dance experience (attend dance schools/clubs out of school)
- ▶ A genuine passion for dance/ performing arts.
- You will be expected to perform in front of others.
- Your performances will be recorded for examination purposes.
- Being organized and meeting deadlines
- You will be expected to complete written theory work.
- You will be expected to work in groups (minimum of 3 maximum of 7).
