

PHILIPS HIGH SCHOOL ASSEMBLIES POLICY

At Philips High School our assemblies aim to:

- Promote awareness of and respect for the values and ideas of other cultures.
- Promote respect for and understanding of other people and any challenges their life and situation presents.
- Be a celebration of festivals and significant events.
- Introduce a wider understanding of human issues and invite representatives of charities, cultural organisations, etc. into the school.
- Provide opportunities to promote our STAR values.
- Provide a focus to regularly celebrate the achievements and work of individuals, teams, groups, societies and the school as a whole.

Pupils take part in one assembly per week with their year group. These assemblies alternate between being led by Heads of Year, and being led by form presentations. These periods of time in the school week are a vital and integral part of pupils Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural Development and support our wider Personal Development Programme at Philips High School (see SMSC Policy and Personal Development Policy).

The assembly rota is drawn up by the Head of Character in collaboration with the Personal Development AHT and distributed to all staff via a shared link on the school desktops. Asselbies are quality assured and there is a folder on the Personal Development shared area for sharing of resource. Form teachers are also encouraged to seek support from the allocated specialist member of staff indicated below.

A key element of all assemblies is reflection time where pupils are encouraged to think deeply about the topic and link this to the schools' ethos and values.
